**The School Board of Broward County
Reassignment Window Opens
May 1st-June 15th
for the 2007-2008 school year.**

The reassignment window allows parents or guardians an opportunity to apply for a reassignment for their child to attend a school other than the one that is in their boundary. The window for this application process will be opened from May 1st through June 15th for the 2007-2008 school year. You may apply online at www.browardschools.com by clicking on the "Reassignment Window Now Open" link located on the left hand side of the home page or go to "Departments" link at the top of the home page. Click on "Pupil placement/Reassignment" and follow directions. Once you have entered the information, press the "submit" button and you will receive a confirmation number acknowledging your application was received. Please print the confirmation page for your records. If you are not able to apply online, applications will be available May 1, 2007 at all Broward County Schools and The Pupil Placement/Reassignment Office located at 7770 West Oakland Park Blvd. If you have any questions you may contact the Pupil Placement/Reassignment Department at 754-321-3035. Only the 2007-2008 applications will be accepted. Please remember that only one application per student will be accepted. Applications received after the window closes will not be accepted. Transportation is not provided with a reassignment. It is the parent's responsibility to provide transportation to the reassigned school.
